WAYNESBURG – Out of an abundance of caution and increasing incidents of positive COVID-19 test results in Greene County, the County Commissioners have decided to close Greene County government buildings. All departments will continue to be available via telephone, but limited services may be available to the public. All essential services will continue.

The county current year property tax discount collection period will begin on Wednesday, April 1st. Tax payers are welcome to submit tax payments by mail. We encourage tax payers to include a stamped self-addressed envelope for the return of their tax payment receipt.

The regularly scheduled Greene County Commissioner's Agenda and Board meetings scheduled for next week are cancelled. The next scheduled meetings will occur at 10:00 am on April 15th and 16th, 2020.
