MINUTES – Commissioner Betsy McClure made the motion and Commissioner Blair Zimmerman the second to approve the minutes from the June 18, 2020 meeting. Vote unanimous.

SECURITY

1. There were two (2) reportable Extraordinary Occurrence Reports (EOR) submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections for the Month of June 2020.
2. The facility issued nine (9) major misconducts and ten (10) minor misconducts for the month of June 2020.

TREATMENT

1. There were no volunteer programs or groups conducted during the month of June 2020.

STAFFING AND TRAINING
