Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 14, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Dave Brendel was the only visitor present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the April meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dan made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously. It was noted that payment was made to Greer Industries in the amount of \$34,321.25 (not listed in the bills for approval) making the State Fund balance \$254,556.92.

Dave Brendel stated again that Greene County is included in the spotted lantern fly quarantine.

Clean Up Days were held in April and were successful.

The code enforcement report was reviewed. Two companies still haven't paid overweight fines. One building permit was issued for a property on Knob Hill Road.

No engineering report was given.


Slusarczyk Excavating, LLC will be moving the bridge on Thursday, May 16th and starting the Grinnage Run Road bridge replacement project next week.

Full depth reclamation has been completed on three roads and oiling and chipping has started. There are road slips on Turkey Hollow and Cole Hollow Roads that should be repaired by Iron Senergy. Mowing of the road banks will begin in June.

The improvements to the exterior of the office building are being completed by Wayne Lumber Co.

The 2023 annual audit has been completed by Cypher & Cypher. The DCED Annual Audit and Financial Report has been submitted and approved by the DCED.
