

Center Township
Board of Supervisors
April 9, 2024
Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. There were no visitors present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dan made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Clean Up Days will be held on April 18th from 8:00 to 4:00, April 19th from 8:00 to 4:00 and on April 20th from 8:00 to 2:00.

The code enforcement report was reviewed. Citations for three road weight violations are pending, all others have been paid.

The notice to proceed has been given to Slusarczyk Excavating, LLC for the Grinnage Run Road bridge replacement project. The anticipated start date will be in May.

Three bids were received for the #8 slag aggregate and the #8 unwashed aggregate.

Paul made a motion to award the contract for the #8 slag to Youngblood Paving. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously. Paul made a motion to award the contract for the #8 unwashed aggregate to Greer Limestone Co. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

\$1,350.00 was received for the 2 blades sold at Behm's consignment auction on March 30th.


The township is in receipt of a letter from Kayla Patton as the President of the Rogersville Youth Baseball and Softball League seeking assistance for the purchase of an AED device to be kept at the park. She has chosen the Philips HeartStart FRx AED with the waterproof carrying case to be best suited for our purposes at a cost of \$2,160.28. Paul suggested that training be provided to use the device. Paul made a motion to purchase the AED and to cover the cost of training provided by EMS Southwest or another qualified instructor. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

No bids were received for the improvements to the exterior of the office building. After meeting with a representative of Progressive Mobility regarding the electronic lift/elevator to be installed at the front entrance, the specifications have changed. The board is currently waiting on the revised specifications and guidance from the township's engineer regarding the required inspections of the elevator.

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The county recently had heavy rains and flooding causing several road slips and washed-out culverts. The county emergency management department is currently accepting Declarations of Disaster, the first step to receiving funding to help cover the cost of road repairs. Paul made a motion to adopt a Declaration of Disaster and Dan seconded. The motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:13 p.m.
