Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, June 11, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Dave Brendel was the only visitor present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the May meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dan made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dave Brendel stated that no spotted lantern flies have been captured in the traps.

Paul stated that the Grinnage Run bridge replacement is going well. The bridge is in and the concrete and ground work are being completed. The contractor hopes to be done this Friday, next week for sure.

The code enforcement report was reviewed. Two companies still haven't paid overweight fines. One new overweight fine notice has been issued. One building permit was issued for a new manufactured home on Oak Forest Road.

No engineering report was given.

Full depth reclamation has been completed on Pettit Road and it was sprayed with ultra-bond. It is now ready for oiling and chipping. The first round of oiling and chipping has been completed on some roads. Extensive work digging out soft spots and removing large trees is taking place on Clark Road. FDR is planned for Center Highlands and Grinnage Run Roads. Mowing of the road banks has begun.

The improvements to the exterior of the office building have been completed. The lift for handicapped accessibility is still in the works. Three windows for the shop are ordered and will be installed.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:12 p.m.
