

Center Township
Board of Supervisors
July 9, 2024
Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, July 9, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Dave Brendel and Nate Regotti were the visitors present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the June meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dave Brendel stated that there have been no reports of spotted lantern flies in the county so far.

Paul reported that the Grinnage Run bridge replacement has been completed, the road is now ready to be oiled and chipped. The Board thanked Iron Senegy again for the purchase of the bridge. Pettit Road has been reclaimed, oiled and chipped and mowed. CNX Gas Co. paid for the reclamation. Tree removal on Clark Road has been completed. The mine is currently plugging wells on Center Highlands and Grinnage Run Roads so there is a lot of traffic on them at this time. A road slip on Cole Hollow Road has been repaired and paid for by the coal company. Mowing of the road banks should be completed this week. The second round of mowing will begin in September.


The monthly code enforcement and engineering reports were not provided.

Paul made a motion to approve the Lightner lot split for 137 Third Street, separating the storage units from the home. Dan seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

The Impact Fee Allocation in the amount of \$847,636.95 was received on June 27, 2024.

Nate Regotti addressed the board regarding an agreement from Community Networking Resources proposing to assist the township in obtaining funds and helping to get proposed projects completed. Nate asked the board to provide a list of projects in order by relevance. The fee for their services is \$4,000.00 per month for a period of 12 months. Nate has already started laying the ground work for funding for the proposed sewer expansion. He stated that his company provides full-service government affairs and explained how his company can benefit the township. Paul asked if their services were a flat fee or if the township would have to pay more for extra work. Nate assured that it was a flat fee. Paul made a motion to hire Community Networking Resources for a period of one year with the stipulation that an update is provided by email prior to the monthly meetings. Harry seconded and the motion was carried.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
