Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, August 13, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Josh Jacoby from Cypher & Cypher was the only visitor present.

Dan made a motion to approve the minutes of the July meeting as read. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Josh from Cypher & Cypher reviewed the 2023 annual audit and presented a thorough report to the board.

The monthly code enforcement report was reviewed. There are no new citations given and two outstanding for overweight violations.

The monthly update from Nate Regotti from Community Networking Resources was reviewed.

Dan made a motion to approve the McNeely lot split. Paul seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

Replacing the high lift was discussed as it is 10 years old and starting to show wear. Five quotes have been received, all through Costars. It was agreed to review the quotes and compare the different machines before making a decision.

Concrete has been poured for the installation of the handicap lift at the main entrance of the office.

The mine will be performing full depth reclamation on Center Highlands Road. They are also paving a section of Buck Hill Road.

The Board of Supervisors met with representatives from Luttamus Communications and CNX Gas for the installation on a radio antenna at the McQuay Compressor Station. New radios will be installed in all the equipment.

Dan made a motion to increase the amount paid to Richard Herrick for the mowing at the township and the fire hall and the mowing and maintenance at the park from \$300.00 to \$350.00 biweekly. Paul seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:34 p.m.
