

Center Township Board of Supervisors
September 10, 2024 Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, September 10, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Harry D. Gillispie, Chairman, Daniel R. Stoneking, Vice Chairman, Paul Cook, Supervisor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. No visitors were present.

Paul made a motion to approve the minutes of the August meeting as read. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Dan made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Four quotes were received for a new wheel loader (High Lift), all through Costars. The first was from Stephenson Equipment for a JCB 2024 427ZX for \$173,900.00 with a \$60,000.00 trade in for a net price of \$113,900.00. Second was from Case Power & Equipment for a 621G at a price of \$204,000.00 with a \$75,000 trade in for a net price of \$129,000.00. The next quote was from Groff Tractor and Equipment for a John Deere 524 P-Tier at \$249,975.00 with a trade in of \$80,000.00 for a net price of \$169,975.00. Last was from Cleveland Brothers for a Caterpillar 926 14A at a price of \$212,600.00 with no trade in. A motion was made by Dan to purchase the JCB 427 ZX as the lowest priced wheel loader. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously. The new JCB will be equipped with the quick coupler for the forks and salt bucket that we already have.

The monthly code enforcement report was reviewed. There are still two outstanding overweight violations. One building permit was issued for alterations at the school and one is pending review for a new home on Hargus Creek Road.

The monthly update from Nate Regotti from Community Networking Resources was reviewed. A meeting is scheduled to discuss funding opportunities on Sept. 23rd.

Paul made a motion to approve the McNay lot split. Dan seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

Paul made a motion to schedule trick or treat for Thursday, October 31st from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Residents wishing to participate should leave outside lights on. Dan seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

The full depth reclamation on Center Highlands Road was completed and a section of Buck Hill Road was paved. The second round of road bank mowing has begun.

The new radios have been installed in all the equipment and the new antenna at the McQuay Compressor Station should be installed within the next couple of weeks.

Clean Up Days will be held on October 10th from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., October 11th from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and October 12th from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Paul made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dan and the meeting was adjourned at 5:24 p.m.
