 - a. The township received its actual Liquid Fuels allocation for 2026 on March 20, in the amount of \$127,755.37, a decrease of \$2,075 over last year's allocation.
 - b. Pursuant to our request, we received a check for \$3,000 from Core Resources (Consol), which is to be used toward the cost of seal coating the asphalt surfaces at the township park.
 - c. We recently received a letter from the Waynesburg-Franklin Township Volunteer Fire Company requesting additional financial assistance in the amount of \$15,000 for calendar year 2026. The township approved and sent them \$15,000 in 2024 and again in 2025. Recommend the request for additional funding will be considered as we develop our 2026-27 Act 13 Spending Plan in July.
