April 14, 2026

Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Frank Basile followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Ronald Howard and Tom Brookover with secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Chuck Obrad, Dave Reese, GWRP Chief William DeForte and Sgt. R. R. Burns, PSP Waynesburg.

Public Comments: (all comments are limited to no more than 5 minutes per person; persons requested to be on the agenda will be recognized first). Sgt. Burns, PSP Station Commander attended to introduce himself and give a brief description of calls in Perry Township. Sgt. Burns thanked the Township and especially the Fire Department for their response to incidents on I-79. The help is truly appreciated. PSP is available by phone and will try to attend functions if requested.

A complaint was received regarding the large amount of scrap/refuse on the Campbell property along Wades Run. The items are getting more in proximity to the creek and any time the water is high, more items are washed downstream creating environmental hazards. Chairman Basile advised the Supervisors will need to investigate what can be done legally.

No fuel bids were received but since we fall under the threshold for phone bids, 4 bids were taken. Sprague at \$4.85, BFS at \$4.56, Stucks at \$3.97 and Woodford at \$4.31. A motion is needed to approve staying with Stuck Enterprises for this year at 3.97 by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.
