May 12, 2026

Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Frank Basile followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board member present, Tom Brookover with secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Chuck Obrad, Dave Reese.

Public Comments: (all comments are limited to no more than 5 minutes per person; persons requested to be on the agenda will be recognized first).

An update was requested regarding the large amount of scrap/refuse on the Campbell property along Wades Run which was brought up last month. Chairman Basile asked Supervisor Brookover if he had addressed the landowner, he has not. Chairman Basile advised he has spoke with the landowner who states the hillside is full of copperhead nests. When the weather turns cold, she will hopefully find someone to start remediation of the area. That is acceptable at this time.

The board was questioned as to the Mt. Morris Water Authority selling the dump truck. It was noted that the Supervisors did not approve or have part of the sale. The Water Authority was instructed in the proper procedures to sell assets under the Municipal Water Authority Act. Procedure was not followed – if there are any issues, the Water Authority will be responsible.

Greene Washington Regional Police report. None received, no one was in attendance.

Code Enforcement Report. Report was read and accepted.

MMVFD proclamation. Resolution 1-2026 acknowledges the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Mt. Morris Volunteer Community Fire Department. This resolution will be framed and presented to the Mt. Morris Volunteer Community Fire Department at their 100<sup>th</sup> celebration. Motion to approve Resolution by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover. Vote: All in favor.

Cesa Agreement. Motion to approve the Road Occupancy permit presented by Ed and June Cesa for a driveway entrance permit on Calvert Hill Road to be able to gain access to their property by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile. Vote: All in favor.

Campground Permit presented by Beaver Run Campground. Application for 29 spaces was approved by Mt. Morris Water and fees are paid. Motion to approve Beaver Run Campground by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover. Vote: All in favor.

Motion to adjourn by Tom Brookover at 3:10pm second by Frank Basile. Vote: All in favor.
